	Mow your lawn, decreasing your blade height by one inch. Aerate your lawn.		Prune perennials, shrubs, and trees.
			Save any bulbs that may not survive the winter months.
	Add fall fertilizer your lawn, garden beds, and trees.		Wrap tree trunks for protection.
			Remove dead plants and shrubs.
	Add soil conditioner to improve the fertility, mechanics, and physical qualities of your soil.		Remove weeds in your lawn and garden beds.
	Rake and bag your grass cuttings Spread mulch in your garden, around your trees, and in plant beds.		Winterize your irrigation system, drain all rain barrels and hoses, and store in a dry location.
			Overseed your lawn.
